Shooting Stars Synchronized Skating Class

Sign up for our newest class: The Synchronized Skating Badge Program

The "Team" will earn the Basis Skills Synchro 1-4 Badges and learn the fundamental skills of synchronized skating in a group lesson setting.

This class will be offered on Tuesday nights from 6:15-7:00pm using half sheet of ice.

Eligibility: Open to any Basic Skills skater Badge 2-8

Fantasy on Ice 2010 Requirements

Below are the requirements for the 2010 Ice Show:

Basic Skill Numbers:

Ice show placement for Snow Plow Sam and Badge levels will be determined immediately following the first test session in December. Skaters will not be placed in groups by ability alone. Age, size, badge level and lesson day all are determining factors left up to the ice show committees discretion for placement.

Low, Middle and High placement will be determined by USFS Tests passed by the **first** day of skating, **September 28, 2009**.

Low Numbers:

Skaters who have passed Freestyle 2.

Any skater passing F2 by the December Basic Skills test session will move up for ice show placement.

Middle Numbers:

Skaters who have passed USFS Preliminary Freestyle Test and are a registered full member of the CFSC by September 28, 2009.

High Numbers:

Skaters who have passed USFS Juvenile Freestyle Test, Intermediate Moves in the Field Test and are a registered full member of the CFSC by September 28, 2009.

Individual Skaters:

Skaters who have passed USFS Intermediate Freestyle Test, Junior Moves in the Field Test, was a registered full member in 2008-2009 and are a registered full member of the CFSC by September 28, 2009 are entitled to a 2 minute full ice solo. Skaters who have passed USFS Juvenile Freestyle Test, Intermediate Moves in the Field Test or higher, was a registered full member in 2008-2009 and are a registered full member of the CFSC by September 28, 2009 are entitled to a 2 minute number left up to the discretion of the Ice Show Committee. **Choreography Professional** must be pre-approved by the ice show committee for all individual skating numbers.

The Elite Number:

If the committee decides to have an elite number, any 2009-2010 registered full member of the CFSC by September 28, 2009 can try out to be in the Elite group. Previous years experience does not guarantee a spot. Tryouts will be determined later.
