Learn To Skate USA

Our Learn to Skate program or LTS as we call it, is for skaters of all ages. LTS classes are taught on Monday or Tuesday night from 6:00 - 7:00 PM. Your registration includes a half hour group lesson and a half hour of practice time. It also includes a second night of practice time.

For example, if you skater has their Group lesson on Monday, then they are welcome to return on Tuesday and practice during that night's LTS lesson time.

The Bridge Program is designed to 'bridge the gap' between structured LTS Group lessons and Open Freestyle skating. Bridge includes badge levels Pre Free - Freeskate 4. Bridge is still under the LTS umbrella however the cost is a little more because you are given more ice time as your skater learns to navigate freestyle skating and time management.

CALLING ALL SKATERS!

Want to experience a different side of skating?

Want to learn leadership and teamwork skills?

Want to form lifelong friendships with other skaters?

If all of that sounds good to you then you need to join our synchronized skating teams!

We are hoping to have 3 teams this year: Silver Blades, Silverettes, and Shooting Stars.

Tryouts: LTS Badge 3 and up!

Tryouts are scheduled for August 28th at 8:30PM at the Whitestown Arena. Our coaches will evaluate our skaters and determine which team they are best suited for based on age and skating level. The Silver Blades & Silverettes teams are competition teams. They will have some exhibitions, competitions and of course perform in our Fantasy on Ice Show. This means there will be some travel/ expenses involved. The Shooting Stars will be a 'house team' which means they will be practicing to become a competition team. They will have opportunities to perform exhibitions and they will perform in our Fantasy on Ice Show.

If you are unsure about what synchronized skating is or if your skater is on the fence about joining, please come to this tryout and learn what all the hype is about! We are happy to help you see if it is something for you.

Synchronized skating is a wonderful way to become part of a team in a highly individualized sport!

Open Freestyle

Open Freestyle skating is for any skater that has passed out of the Bridge Program's Freeskate 4. Freestyle has various open ice times but does not include structured group lessons. By CFSC rules, you must be taking private lessons with a certified coach.

Family Discount - Second Family Member: \$35 discount. Three or more immediate family members receive a 10% discount on membership fees (excluding synchro, and Ice Show Assessment)

Additional Membership Fee - An Ice Show assessment of \$75 for each individual member (maximum of \$100 per family) completes your membership requirement. This fee is payable through ticket sales for the Ice Show, whether the skater participates in the show or not.

***Joint Membership** – Includes 1 Freestyle session per week & 1 number in our Ice Show to be decided by the show committee. \$75 Assessment will apply.

+College Student /Adult Membership - for students & adult freestyle skaters. Fee includes 2 sessions per week. This does not include our annual Fantasy on Ice show



New This Season!

Open Freestyle & Bridge will be offered two new opportunities this season!

Coach's Choice - This season we have asked our coaches to teach a class during the last half hour of Friday's Freestyle ice. The class and the coach will change from week to week and we will have the subject posted on the calendar on our website. This class is included in your registration fees.

Edges Plus - The Edges Plus class will be held on Sunday mornings. Much like the Skills Class we offered last year, this class will cover a variety of things from edges, power skating, spins etc. The class will be a half hour on the ice followed by a half hour off the ice in the Shooting Room upstairs. This class will be \$125 for the season and open to Bridge and Freestyle.

In Other News...

Ice Monitors Needed!

Every season we offer the opportunity to our skaters to volunteer as Ice Monitors. Ice Monitors help out our newer skaters during the practice ice times of Learn To Skate lessons and often are asked by our coaches to assist with the lessons.

Monitors must be at least 12 years of age & a Freestyle skater.

Our Volunteers will be able to earn hours they need for academic requirements and get more time on the ice and with our coaches. They will also have the opportunity to become role models for our younger skaters and are recognized at our annual banquet. It's a win - win situation for everyone!

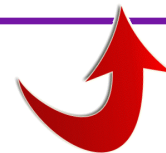
Board Positions
